

Applications are invited for the following positions:

### ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (ENVIRONMENTAL LAW), CENTRE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES IN ENVIRONMENTAL LAW AND POLICY – AC/12/334/19 (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants must be holders of an earned Ph.D degree in Law from a recognized University with at least eight (8) years teaching and practical experience in environmental law, land use law, climate change, biodiversity and natural resources management at both undergraduate and postgraduate degree level, three (3) of which must be at Senior Lecturer level. They must have supervised to completion at least two (2) students at doctoral level and three (3) students at masters level. Applicants must have a minimum of forty eight (48) equivalent publication points as Senior Lecturer, of which at least thirty two (32) should be from refereed scholarly journals. In addition, they should have knowledge and experience in multilateral environmental negotiations and law practices. They must also have attracted research or development funds as Senior Lecturer level.

The successful candidate will be expected to provide academic leadership, teach and supervise at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. They will also be expected to carry out research and design programmes in environmental diplomacy. They will also be expected to participate in Centre, School, College and University activities.

### LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACOLOGY AND PHARMACOGNOSY – AC/12/335/19 (I POST) (CHS)

Applicants must be holders of a PhD degree in Pharmacology (with specialization in Pharmacodynamics, Pharmacokinetics, Bioinformatics, Drug discovery, Molecular or Systems Pharmacology) or PhD degree in Pharmacoepidemiology, Pharmacovigilance, Health Policy, Health Systems or Health Economics from a recognized university. Applicants should have at least three (3) years teaching experience at University level both at undergraduate and post graduate levels and research experience with at least twenty four (24) publication points, of which sixteen (16) should be from refereed scholarly journals. They should show evidence of continued research activity.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students and undertake research in their area of specialization. They are also expected to participate in Departmental, School and College activities.

### LECTURER, AFRICAN WOMEN STUDIES CENTRE – AC/12/336/19 (I POST) (CHSS)

Applicants must be holders of a PhD degree in the area of Women Leadership Studies or related disciplines from a recognized university. Applicants should have at least three (3) years teaching experience at University level both at undergraduate and post graduate levels and research experience with at least twenty four (24) publication points, of which sixteen (16) should be from refereed scholarly journals. They should demonstrate expertise in gender/women and development approaches and a critical appraisal of a feminist theory. They should also show evidence of continued research activity.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students and undertake research in their area of specialization with focus on feminist theories and their application to the African context; theoretical and philosophical basis of women's oppression; a historical approach to African feminism; women's movement organizations and groups in Africa; and feminist ideology and governance in Africa. They are also expected to participate in Centre and College activities.

### LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRICAL AND INFORMATION ENGINEERING – AC/12/337/19 (1 POST) (CAE)

Applicants must be holders of a PhD degree in Electrical and Electronic Engineering or a related discipline from a recognized university. Applicants should have at least three (3) years teaching experience at University level both at undergraduate and post graduate levels and research experience with at least twenty four (24) publication points, of which sixteen (16) should be from refereed scholarly journals.
