Some of these platforms limit the numbers per session and therefore may require you to group your students whatever the method you chose to use, it is recommended to break your students to small groups for large classes.

I note that many of you have received training on the use of Google Classroom and therefore are well familiar with its use.

2. For the sake of students who may have challenges to connect for some reasons, including timing of the lecture, it would be appropriate to record the sessions and share with them via email or WhatsApp.


