Admission Requirements:

Admission Requirements:

- C+ in KCSE with at least C (plain) in Biology or Biological Sciences and any one of the following subjects: Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics or Physical Sciences or Geography.
- Two principals and one subsidiary pass at KACE level or equivalent, one of which must be in Biology and the other in any Science subject.
- 3. C- in (minus) in KCSE plus a Certificate and Diploma in a biological science from a recognized institution.
- Bachelor of Science degree in a Biological Science from a recognized institution.

DIPLOMA IN ANIMAL HEALTH AND PRODUCTION

Admission Requirements:

The common admission requirements for diploma courses of the University of Nairobi shall apply. Applicants with the following qualifications shall be admissible.

- Holders of a Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) aggregate of C and a grade of at least C in Biology or Biological sciences, Chemistry or Physical Science and any of the following science subject: Mathematics, Physics or Agriculture.
- Holders of Kenya Certificate of Education (KCE) Division II with at least a credit in chemistry, biology and any other one science subject or Physical Science or Agriculture.
- Holders of an "A" level certificate with a minimum of one principal pass and at least a subsidiary pass in biology and chemistry.

- Holders of a credit pass certificate in animal health/agriculture from institutions recognized by the University senate with at least an aggregate of C- at KCSE or Division III at KCE.
- Holders of a diploma in biomedical discipline recognized by University of Nairobi senate.
- Any other equivalent qualification recognized by University of Nairobi senate.

DIPLOMA IN LEATHER TECHNOLOGY

Admission Requirements:

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) aggregate of C with a grade of at least C- in Chemistry and any one of the following subjects; Biology Physics or Physical Science
- KCSE mean grade C- with at least grade C- in Chemistry or equivalent plus a Certificate in a relevant professional field from institutions recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate
- "A" level Certificate with a minimum of two subsidiary Pass one of which must be in Chemistry and the other in Biology, Physics of Physical Science
- 4. Any other qualification recognized by the University of Nairobi senate

DIPLOMA IN VETERINARY PUBLIC HEALTH AND MEAT TECHNOLOGY

Admission Requirements:

The common admission requirements for diploma courses in the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Nairobi shall apply. Applicants with any one of following minimum qualifications shall be admissible:

- Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) mean grade C or equivalent with at least grade C- in Biology and any one of the following subjects; Chemistry, physics, mathematics, geography or Biological Science.
- KCSE mean grade C- with at least grade C- in Biology,and any one of the following subjects; Chemistry, physics, mathematics, geography or Biological Science) plus a Certificate in a relevant biological discipline from an institution recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate.
- Kenya Certificate of Education (KCE) Division III or equivalent with at least a pass in Chemistry and Biology.
- 'A' level with a minimum of two subsidiary passes or equivalent; one of which must be in Biology, and the other in Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, or Geography.
- A Certificate in Animal Health from an institution recognized by University of Nairobi Senate.
- Equivalent qualifications to the above from institutions recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate.

B.Sc. FOOD NUTRITION AND DIETETICS

Admission Requirements

- Holders of KCSE with a mean grade C+ and a minimum of C+ in Biology or Biological Sciences, Chemistry or Physical Sciences, Mathematics or Physics and English or Kiswahili.
- Holders of Diploma in Nutrition and Dietetics or Nutrition and Food Sciences or equivalent with KCSE mean grade C+ or above.
- Holders of 'O' level Division I or II or equivalent with the subjects indicated in 3.1 above; plus a Diploma in Nutrition and Dietetics or Nutrition and Food Sciences from an institution recognized by the Senate
- Holders of 'A' level with two Principal Passes or equivalent in Biology and any one of the following subjects: Chemistry, Physics. or Mathematics
- Holders of a Bachelor of Science degree in Biological Sciences or related sciences from an institution recognized by the Senate.

BSc. HORTICULTURE

Admission requirements

Business Studies.
- Holders of K.A.C.E or equivalent with minimum 2 principal passes in Biology and Chemistry and at least a subsidiary pass in Mathematics. If Mathematics was not offered at K.A.C.E, then it is accepted at Ordinary Level but with a minimum of a credit pass.
- Holders of a Diploma in Biological Sciences or related sciences from a recognized institution with credit or distinction, with KCSE mean grade of C or above.
- Holders of a degree in biological sciences or related sciences from a recognized University

BSc. AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION AND EXTENSION

Admission Requirements

- KCSE with mean grade C+
- KCSE with mean grade C- plus a Certificate and Diploma.
- O Level Division II plus a Diploma.
- O Level Division III plus a Certificate and Diploma.
- O Level Division III plus a three-year Diploma from post secondary Institution.
- Diploma and an aggregate of C plain in KCSE.

Admission requirements

Overall mean grade C+ and grade C+ in the following subject clusters: English or Kiswahili, Mathematics, Physics or Chemistry or Biology or Physical Science or Biological Science, Art and Design or Drawing and Design or Building Construction or Music or Economics or Geography or Social Education and Ethics or History & Government, Christian religious Education / Islamic Religious Education.

(II) 'A' Level Candidates or Equivalent

Two Principal passes in Mathematics and any one of the following subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Geography, Economics, Art & Design, and a credit pass in English language at K.C.E or equivalent examination.

(III) Diploma Holders

A holder of (KNEC) Diploma in Architecture, Building Construction or related fields with a pass or equivalent.

(IV) Degree Holders

A holder of a degree from a recognized University in the following: Land Economics, Building economics, Design, Civil Engineering, Surveying, Urban and Regional Planning or any other relevant degree.

In Category (iii) and (iv) above, candidates may be required to present portfolios and appear for interviews.

(II) 'A' Level Candidates or Equivalent
