Applications are invited for the following position:

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACEUTICS AND PHARMACY PRACTICE - AC/6/165/21 - (R&T) - 1 POST

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD or equivalent in Clinical Pharmacy, Industrial Pharmacy or Pharmaceutics from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate. In addition, the applicant should be holder of a Master's degree in any of the above named relevant fields. They must also have a minimum of eight (8) years teaching experience at both undergraduate and postgraduate degree levels, three (3) of which must have been at Senior Lecturer level, Senior Research Fellow or three (3) years of industry experience in the relevant area. The applicant must have supervised to completion a minimum of five (5) postgraduate students, at least two (2) at Doctoral level and three (3) at Masters level; OR a minimum of ten (10) Masters students. He/she must have a minimum of thirty two (32) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of five (5) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion; OR a minimum of three (3) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly book chapters/two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers/two (2) published teaching/lecture modules since last promotion. He/she must have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as a Senior Lecturer or Senior Research Fellow since his/her last promotion. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Kenya.

The successful candidate will be expected to provide academic leadership, teach, mentor and supervise students at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. He/she will also be expected to carry out further research in his/her area of specialization and participate in Departmental, School, College and University activities as well as perform clinical duties at the Kenyatta National Hospital.
