The Project

The University of Nairobi, Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics has been awarded a five (5) year research grant by Centre for Disease Control (CDC) under the title, "Monitor and Prevent Antimicrobial Resistance in Kenya (MAP-AMR Kenya)". The Project will be conducted in three (3) hospitals, namely: Kenyatta National Hospital, The Nairobi Hospital and the Spinal Injury Hospital. The Project seeks to competitively fill the above named position.

The Position

This is a full time position based at the University of Nairobi, Department of Clinical Medicine and Therapeutics, with the holder of the position reporting to the Data Manager/Scientist.

Job description

- Enter data on an online platform and scan data documents.
- Prepare new patient files and ensure all files contain the required forms.
- Conduct weekly data quality checks with guidance from the Data Manager and maintain data cleanliness.
- Maintain a clean log frame of data queries and how they have been resolved.

Job specifications

- An applicant must have a Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Statistics and IT
- He or she should have one (1) year experience in IT and data entry.
- In addition, he or she must have experience working in a data-handling environment.
- An applicant who has worked on online data entry platform will have an added advantage.
