The Position

This is a full time position based in Nairobi.

Job description

The holder of this position will work to ensure the development and implementation of a range of behavioral change and mobilization activities in reaching the key population and young men fifteen (15) years plus with VMMC. He or she will ensure quality care to key populations, that is, FSW, MSW, Transgender and MSM including the young men fifteen (15) years and plus (VMMC) using health-oriented approach including capacity building of the clinical technical team and facility staff.

Job specifications

The applicant should have a degree in Clinical Medicine with at least four (4) years' experience
OR

Diploma in Clinical Medicine with at least seven (7) years' experience working in a similar field.

Terms of appointment
