LECTURER, SCHOOL OF COMPUTING AND INFORMATICS - AC/2/55/21 - (CBPS) - 1 POST

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD in Computer Science or equivalent qualification specializing in either Computing Systems, Architectures, Computational Intelligent Systems or Information Systems, or related field from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate OR a Masters degree qualification (plus a PhD registration) in the named specialty areas from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases). Experience in enterprise system development and implementation will be an added advantage. They must also have a minimum of three (3) years teaching and research experience at university level or in research or in industry in the relevant area. The applicant must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals, two (2) scholarly book chapters OR; two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers OR; two (2) published teaching/lecture modules. The applicant must be registered with the relevant professional body and demonstrate evidence of community service.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach, examine, mentor and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students. He/she will also be expected to contribute measurably to the School's research, consultancy and outreach agenda, participate in the School activities such as curriculum development and administration as well as perform any other duties assigned by the Director.
