Applications are invited for the following position:

SENIOR LECTURER, DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACEUTICS AND PHARMACY PRACTICE - AC/6/166/21 - (R&T) - 1 POST

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD or equivalent in Clinical Pharmacy, Industrial Pharmacy or Pharmaceutics from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate. In addition, the applicant should be holder of a Master's degree in any of the above named relevant fields. They must also have a minimum of three (3) years university teaching experience at Lecturer or Research Fellow level OR a minimum of six (6) years of industry experience in the relevant field. The applicant must have supervised to completion a minimum of one (1) PhD and one (1) Masters student; OR a minimum of three (3) Masters students. He/she must have a minimum of twenty four (24) publication points from peer reviewed journals with; a minimum of four (4) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion; OR a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly book chapters; OR a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals and two (2) peer reviewed working, discussion or occassional papers or two (2) published teaching/lecture modules since the last promotion. He/she must have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as a Lecturer or Research Fellow since his/her last promotion. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Kenya and with a valid practicing license.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students and undertake further research in his/her area of specialization. He/she will also be expected to participate in Department, School, College and University activities as well as perform clinical duties at the Kenyatta National Hospital.
