#### Bachelor of Arts (BA) Degree Programmes

- KCSE (Mean C+); or KCSE (Mean C) plus a Diploma from a recognized institution; or KCSE (Mean C-) plus a Certificate and a Diploma from a recognized institution; or "O" Level Division III (EACE or KCE) with a Diploma; or "A" Level (EAACE or KACE) with two Principal Passes
- 44 Course Units to be taken in a minimum of 7 semesters

#### Master of Arts (MA) Degree Programmes

- Bachelors Degree in a relevant field from a recognized University
- Those with Lower Second Class Division should have two years postgraduate experience in the relevant field
- 12 Course Units with a Project or 8 Course Units with a Thesis to be taken in a minimum of 4 Semesters

#### Entry Requirements

- A holder of a Master of Arts in Anthropology degree of the University of Nairobi.
- A holder of a Master of Arts in Anthropology degree of a recognized university whose degree has been accepted by Senate to be equivalent.
- Holders of a Masters degree in a discipline other than Anthropology shall be eligible for registration if they satisfy Senate that they possess sufficient foundation in Anthropology to be able to pursue studies and research in, and write a thesis on anthropology subject.

#### Form and Duration of Registration

A candidate registered for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy shall carry out a programme of original study and research over a minimum of two years on a full-time basis and four years on a part-time basis.
