Applications are invited for the following position:

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, CENTRE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES IN ENVIRONMENTAL LAW AND POLICY (CASELAP) - AC/1/6/21 (1 POST) (R&T)

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD degree or equivalent in Law from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate. They must also have a minimum of eight (8) years teaching experience in Environmental Law, Land Use Law and Natural Resources Law both at undergraduate and postgraduate level, at least three (3) of which must have been at Senior Lecturer level/Senior Research Fellow or three (3) years of industry experience in the relevant field. The applicant must have supervised to completion a minimum of five (5) postgraduate students, at least two (2) at Doctoral level and three (3) at Masters level. He/she must have a minimum of thirty two (32) publication points from peer reviewed journals with a minimum of five (5) publications in refereed scholarly journals since last promotion OR a minimum of three (3) publications in refereed scholarly journals or two (2) published teaching/lecture modules since last promotion. He/she must have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as a Senior Lecturer/Senior Research Fellow since his/her last promotion. The applicant must also show evidence of community service. He/she must be registered with relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will be expected to provide academic leadership and engage in teaching and supervision. They will also be expected to carry out research in their areas of specialization and participate in Centre, College and University activities.
