The University of Nairobi, School of Business in collaboration with ARUA Center of Excellence for Unemployment and Skills Development (University of Lagos), John Pappajohn Entrepreneurship Center (University of Iowa, USA) is organizing a 12 day training of trainers for scholars interested in promoting entrepreneurship and innovation among the University students. The training is fully funded by the UKRI-GCFR GRANT titled: Partnership, Research and Capacity-Building for Youth Unemployment Solutions in Africa.

The training will be held from 12<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2021. The training will take place at the University of Nairobi and will be face to face with some sessions delivered virtually.

The goal of this Train-The-Trainer Program in Entrepreneurship and Innovation Mentorship Education Certification (EIMAC) is to empower participants to create awareness and impart skills for job creation to their students in their respective disciplines and hence contribute in creating sustainable and impactful entrepreneurship. The objective being to develop on-the-ground mentors in all Faculties to support the students in innovation and project ideas at the early stage to assist as the enablers of bright ideas that can lead to birth of innovative enterprises across all disciplines.

Due to the prevailing Covid-19 situation, this phase of the programme will target 50 participants only drawn from various Schools/Faculties/Institutes within the University of Nairobi and other neighbouring Universities who are members of ARUA.

Staff from all disciplines are invited to express interest. Selection criteria will ensure fair representation of disciplines, gender and experience in promoting entrepreneurship among the youth.
