The Graduate School is responsible for the co-ordination of graduate programmes with respect to syllabi admission of students, administration of scholarships, research grants monitoring, student progress examinations and the general welfare of graduate students.

The University has over 15,000 graduate students enrolled in over 338 programmes in doctoral, fellowships, masters and graduate diplomas. The population of graduate students continue to increase due to the introduction of relevant and innovative programmes which meet the needs of individual students.

Admission Requirements

GRADUATE

DIPLOMAS AND CERTIFICATES

Applicants for Graduate diplomas and certificates should have a minimum of a pass degree. In addition KCSE+ or KCSE C plus Diploma or KCSE C- plus Diploma and Certificate

MASTERS

DEGREE & FELLOWSHIPS

Applicants for Masters degree programmes should have a minimum of an upper second class honours degree in the relevant discipline from the University of Nairobi or equivalent qualification from institutions recognized by Senate.

Applicants for fellowship programmes should have a masters degree programme in the relevant discipline from the University of Nairobi or equivalent qualification from institutions recognized by Senate.

Persons with lower qualifications but with publications and graduate diplomas and requisite graduation relevant work experience after a Bachelor degree are also considered for admission.

DOCTOR OF

PHILOSOPHY DEGREE

Applicants for the Doctor of Philosophy degree should have a Masters degree from the University of Nairobi or an equivalent qualification from institutions recognized by Senate.

Applicants for Ph.D programmes offered by coursework, examination and thesis should upload certified copies of the following documents for:

- (i) O level Certificate
- (ii) Bachelors degree certificate and academic Transcripts
- (iii) Masters degree certificate and academic Transcripts

Applicants for Ph.D programmes offered by thesis only should upload certified copies of the following documents:

- (i) O level Certificate
- (ii) Bachelors degree certificate and academic Transcripts
- (iii) Masters degree certificate and academic Transcripts
- (iv) Research proposal

Attachments Required for a Postgraduate Application for Admission

The Graduate School has observed that many applications are often shortlisted without all the required attachments/documents and forwarded to Graduate School with a recommendation for admission. 4. Applicants with KCSE C- (minus) to attach certified copies of a certificate and a diploma from KNEC in addition to those stated in 1 & 2
5. Certified copies of masters degree certificate and transcripts
6. PhD Proposal

NB: International applicants;

- (i) To attach documents certified by the university attended
- (ii) Show evidence of accreditation status of that university
- (iii) Proof of English proficiency for non-English speaking countries only
- (iv) Translated documents into English for applicants from non-English speaking countries should be attached

Applicants with missing documents should be requested to upload them before they are shortlisted.

ONLINE COURSE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step 1: Visit the application website <http://application.uonbi.ac.ke>

Step 2: Registration and creation of user account

To register, you need an email address which will be validated during the registration process. Every applicant must create their own personal user account.

Step 3: Profile Management

Key-in your personal details and upload scanned copies of academic certificates and a passport photograph. Only when your profile is complete can you apply for the programme you wish to undertake.

Step 4: Programme Selection

Select and apply for the course you are interested in studying. You will be issued with a REFERENCE NUMBER and directed to pay the prescribed application fee. You can pay the application fees using:

- (i) Credit/Debit Card
- (ii) Mpesa Pay Bill
- (iii) Direct Cash deposit at any KCB branch

Upon payment, you will receive a confirmation of the payment on the email address and phone registered in Step 2

Step 5: Application Tracking

Track the status of your application online through the system. Status alerts will be sent to your registered email address and phone number.

Commencement Dates

These vary from one programme to another. However, the academic year commences in September of each calendar year. In addition, a few programmes have January and May intakes. Programmes under the ODeL mode undertake their residential sessions during the months of April, August and December.

Students are required to know the semester dates to help them in preparing for exams and guide them on the availability of supervisors.

All graduate students are expected to confirm their admission, as indicated in their admission letters, and to undergo biometric registration in their Colleges/School/ Institutes and Centre before they can commence their study programmes.

Fees

All fees and other charges due shall be paid at the commencement of each semester and in any case not beyond the third week of the semester. No student shall be allowed into lectures, examinations rooms or participate in activities for which they have not fully paid for. It is important to note that

fees and other charges are applicable to the current academic year and may be subject to review in the subsequent years. International students are required to pay their fees in dollars.

International Students

The University of Nairobi offers many Masters and PhD programmes that enable for students from diverse areas both regionally and internationally to enroll, learn, research and further their academic knowledge. Currently, the University of Nairobi hosts international students from 41 countries.

The Centre for International Programmes and Links (CIPL) is a unit in the University of Nairobi, that is charged with the responsibility of providing a focal point for handling the affairs of international students and their activities while at the University of Nairobi. International students must register with CIPL which is based at the Main Campus

CIPL has been mandated to assist the students in processing of the Pupil's Pass. Therefore international students should apply for pupils pass through CIPL. However, students are expected to pay for the pupils pass annually (each academic year).

I felt a sense of belonging in the country originating from the good reception from the university where by every office was welcoming.


Scholarships

The University offers a few scholarships to graduate students and these are allocated on merit.
