LECTURER (PARASITOLOGY, VIROLOGY, ENTOMOLOGY, BACTERIOLOGY SECTION), DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY – AC/1/11/21 (2 POSTS) (CHS)

Applicants are required to have an earned PhD degree or equivalent in a relevant field from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate OR a MSc. Degree in Medical Microbiology or MSc. Degree in Tropical and Infectious Diseases or M.Med degree in Pathology (plus a PhD registration) from a university recognized by University of Nairobi Senate (in special cases) with at least three (3) years teaching experience at university level or in research or in industry in the relevant area. Applicants must have a minimum of eight (8) publication points from peer reviewed journals with a minimum of two (2) publications in refereed scholarly journals or two (2) scholarly book chapters or two (2) peer reviewed working/discussion/occasional papers or two (2) published teaching/lecture modules. Applicants must also show evidence of community service. They must be registered with relevant professional body where applicable.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise undergraduate and postgraduate students and undertake research in their area of specialization. They are also expected to provide routine diagnostic services at Kenyatta National Hospital, in addition to participating in Departmental, School and College activities.
