Purpose of Position

The incumbent's areas of research will entail mucosal immunology work which involves direct visualisation of the mucosal tissue barriers, host target or effector cells, and infected cells using explant models.

Key Responsibilities

- i) Live cell microscopy using state-of-the-art confocal and widefield fluorescence microscopes
- ii) Molecular biology techniques such as amplification, sequencing and analysing DNA or rRNA genes
- iii) Performance of flow cytometry assays
- iv) Generation and characterization of replicative-competent HIV-1 primary viruses
- v) Performance of ex vivo explant experiments
- vi) Presentation of results to the group, programme and network

Required Academic Qualifications and experience

- i) Undergraduate degree in biological sciences, biomedical sciences, molecular biology, biotechnology or related fields
- ii) Computer literacy with proficiency in Microsoft applications
- iii) At least one year experience in mucosal immunology research
