Overall Job Purpose

KAVI-Institute of Clinical Research (KAVI-ICR), University of Nairobi, is seeking to recruit a highly motivated early career postdoctoral scientist. The areas of research will entail translational HIV B-cell immunology work that will include characterization of B cells and isolation/characterization of novel anti-HIV monoclonal antibodies.

Key Responsibilities

- i) Fluorescence-activated cell sorting on relevant B cells from PBMCs
- ii) Molecular biology techniques such as amplification, sequencing and analysing immunoglobulin genes
- iii) Preparation of libraries for Next-Generation sequencing
- iv) Generation of recombinant monoclonal antibodies and antigens
- v) Performance of neutralization assays
- vi) Basic bioinformatics analyses on Next-Generation sequencing data
- vii) Technology transfer between partners and collaborators
- viii)Training and supervision of technicians and interns
- ix) Presentation of results to the group, programme and network
- x) Preparation of scientific manuscripts
- xi) Any other responsibilities that may arise from time to time
