## SENIOR LECTURER, INSTITUTE OF DIPLOMACY AND INTERNATIONAL STUDIES – AC/1/15/21 (2 POSTS) (R&T)

Applicants must have an earned PhD degree or equivalent in International Studies from a university recognized by the University of Nairobi Senate. They must have specific expertise in either International Economics or International Law. They must have a minimum three (3) years experience at Lecturer/Research Fellow level or a minimum of six (6) years of industry experience in a relevant field. They must have supervised to completion a minimum of one (1) PhD students and one (1) Masters student OR three (3) Masters students. They should have a minimum of twenty-four (24) publication points from peer reviewed journals with a minimum of four (4) peer reviewed scholarly journals since last promotion OR two (2) peer reviewed scholarly journals and two (2) scholarly published teaching/lecture modules or two (2) working/discussion/occasional papers since last promotion. They must have attracted research or development funds or educational resources as Lecturer/Research Fellow. They must be registered with a relevant professional body (where applicable) and should show evidence of community service.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach and supervise both undergraduate and postgraduate students, carry out further research in their areas of specialization and participate in College and Institute activities.
